

## UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS YEAR 7-11 - BOYS

Uniform may be purchased online from Premier Schoolwear ([www.premierschoolwear.co.uk](http://www.premierschoolwear.co.uk)) or alternatively you may also visit their shop at 688-690 Becontree Avenue, Dagenham, Essex RM8 3HD. A sample of sizes will be available in school to view if you wish. Blouses, skirts, shirts and trousers may be purchased from other suppliers but must conform to the styles below.

Please take particular note of the regulations concerning topcoats.

**NO JEWELLERY IS ALLOWED.** Hair must not be dyed, cropped very short (number one or two) or worn excessively long - certainly not so long that it would need to be tied back. No 'steps' or extreme styles and no excessive use of gel or mousse or similar substances. Appearance should be neat and tidy.

**ALL ITEMS MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED.**

We are advised by the police that cyclists should wear a safety helmet and reflective chest-waist bands in orange or yellow and we recommend these items to you.

**Matters of appearance are inevitably subjective at times.  
Final decisions MUST REST WITH THE SCHOOL.**

ITEM	DESCRIPTION
BLAZER	<i>Dark navy regulation with school badge on pocket. Blazers need not be worn in school during hot summer weather, but NO OTHER top garment may be substituted for it, either in school or for the journey to and from school.</i>
TROUSERS	<i>Plain <b>dark grey</b> worsted-type texture. Not excessively full, tapered or flared.</i>
SHIRT	<i>Long-sleeved light blue school shirt. 'Trutex' type.</i>
SCHOOL TIE	<i>The new clip-on tie will match the colours of the pullover. It has a light blue and a yellow stripe. THIS IS THE ONLY TIE PERMITTED IN YEARS 7-11.</i>
PULLOVER	<i>This v-necked item has a light blue and a yellow stripe around the neck and is the only pullover we permit. You may not wear hooded jumpers beneath blazers or coats.</i>
SOCKS	<i><b>Plain</b> dark grey or black.</i>
SHOES	<i>We recommend <b>plain</b> leather black lace-up or <b>plain</b> leather black slip-on - no buckles. No boots, trainers, deck-shoes, suede, "chunky" soles, zips decorative eyelets, decorative lacing, decorative stitching or 'designer labels' that show. No "Kickers".</i>
SCHOOL BAG	<i>Following publicity regarding children with back problems, we are strongly recommending a rucksack style bag to be carried on both shoulders. This must be <b>plain</b> black or navy.</i>
FOOD TECHNOLOGY APRON	<i>Blue and white striped apron. Student's name should be embroidered in <b>red</b> on the front bib.</i>
TOPCOAT	<i>Plain black raincoat, Parka, kagoul or a black topcoat of suitable warm material. No accessories, stripes, logos or emblems. <b>MUST BE LONGER THAN BLAZER LENGTH. NOT 'BOMBER' TYPE JACKETS.</b></i>
SUMMER SHIRT	<i>As described above but short sleeved for wearing with school tie. This item must be worn tucked in for smart appearance.</i>
SCARF	<i>This is available in red or navy fleece material with a school crest. No football or any other type of scarf is permitted.</i>
GLOVES	<i>Plain black or navy.</i>
