Did you know that there are many free on-line resources that you can access from any computer that has Internet access?

Regardless of whether or not you live in Havering, you may join Havering Libraries and be given a library card and pin number. This card and pin will allow children to use the libraries e-service 24 hours a day.

Encyclopaedia Britannica – articles, videos, illustrations, map and graphics, a world atlas and over 150 journals and magazines (with child friendly interfaces available).

Oxford Reference Online – over a hundred dictionaries and reference books on various topics by Oxford University Press.

Oxford Dictionary of National Biography – biographies of people born in Britain or who made significant contributions to British History.

Grove Art – articles, dictionaries and books on visual arts and World Art from prehistory to the present day. Art images, biographies and links to museum sites.

Grove Music – 3-D interactive images and audible music examples. Articles on people, places instruments, techniques, genres, styles. Biographies, bibliographies, works lists and more.

Oxford English Dictionary – Trace the evolution of 600,000 words over the last 1,500 years.

Infotrac Custom Newspapers – full text articles from National Newspapers from today back to several years ago.

To Join:

Children under 16 need parental permission to join the library and parents/carers have to fill out and sign the joining form and bring adult ID with proof of name and address.
