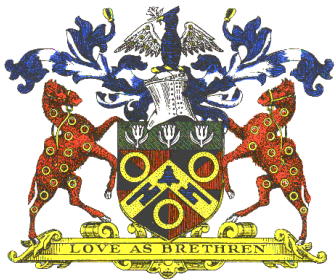

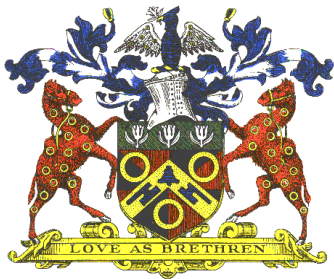

- All students will be admitted onto FOUR AS Level programmes of study, with the expectation of completing at least 3 A2s in Year 13 (excluding General Studies/Critical Thinking).
- Admission is dependent on students attaining AT LEAST A\*-C grades in 8 subjects, including English and Maths
- Each post-16 course has its own entry criteria. Consequently to gain admission to the Sixth Form, all applicants **MUST** meet the specific entry requirements for each course they seek to take as outlined in the prospectus.
