The key principles from the existing Coopers' Charter are supplemented by the following four new areas:

Arrival & Departures:

- Avoid public transport, where at all possible - walk/bike is best
- If you have to use public transport you should observe social distancing whilst queuing/waiting and wear a face covering
- Observe social distancing at all times on the way to/from school
- Wash or sanitise your hands on arrival at the school site.
- You should not go into any shops unnecessary on your way to/from school and if you do you should wear a mask.
- Upon arrival, please arrive only at your allocated time, and enter via your allocated entrance.
- In the morning, you should go directly to your Form Room, only deviating if you need to go to your locker/allocated toilet
- At the end of the school day, please leave the school site immediately

Hygiene:

- Sanitise/wash your hands-on multiple occasions during the school day; this is non-negotiable. This is particularly important before/after eating/drinking/going to the toilet/upon arrival/leaving the school site
- Sanitise your hands when you walk into a classroom
- Face masks must be worn in communal/public areas and adhere to our School Behaviour policy and must be removed in classrooms/outside areas
- In practical subjects, follow the enhanced cleaning routines.
- Due to touching your mouth, chewing gum is strictly prohibited as usual
- You should avoid touching surfaces unnecessarily – door handles etc
- You must not share any food/drink with any members of the school community
- You must not share any stationary equipment with other students
- You should avoid touching your mouth/nose and eyes and if you do you should wash/sanitise your hands
- Students should adopt a 'catch it, kill it, bin it' approach to sneezing and should bring tissues to school with them
- You must not 'spit' under any circumstances

Socialising:

- You will only be able to socialise with students in your year group 'bubble' once on the school site – and when you do so it is recommended that you socially distance, where possible.
- If socialising inside, in a communal area, then a face mask must be worn
- Remain in your year group 'zone' at break and lunchtime
- No shared sports will be able to operate at break/lunch (basketball/football/table tennis)
- You should avoid ALL physical contact with other students, including those in your year group 'bubble'

Moving around the school site:

- Lockers should be accessed before and after school – students should avoid using them, where possible, during the school day.
- When moving to a lesson outside of your year group zone, go directly to that lesson and no-where else and wear a face mask
- Only use the toilets allocated to your year group bubble.
- Students should enter the classroom upon arrival, not queue up in communal areas
- The one-way system, must be observed at all times – this is a public health issue
