**Integration Day: Trip to Stubbers Adventure Centre**

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s)

On Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> September, we have our 'Adventure Integration Day' in the Sixth Form, when all of Year 12 are off from their traditional academic timetable. In order for the new year group to integrate fully we have arranged for all students to attend Stubbers Adventure Centre in Upminster for post-16 teambuilding. We feel this is so important this year, due to all the disruption of the past 18 months.

The day will represent an excellent opportunity for the cohort, their tutors and the pastoral team in the Sixth Form to get to know each other better and also to have some fun after a hectic first of week of term!

The day will involve the Sixth Formers walking to the centre, from school and participating in a variety of activities from climbing, archery, rifle shooting, kayaking, high ropes, abseiling, tunnelling and fencing. All activities will be completely supervised by fully-qualified centre staff and the strictest safety standards will be maintained through the day. Students should arrive at school at 8:30am as usual and will be back on site by 4:15pm at the latest.

The day has been subsidised by the school, to reduce the cost to you. There will, however, be a charge of £40 which will involve instruction, hire of equipment and insurance. We hope you agree this is excellent value for a full day of outdoor activities including watersports. The trip can only take place with a voluntary contribution made by parents/guardians. Please pay on ParentPay and complete the Google Form (details below) as soon as possible. If you are unable to pay the full contribution please contact the finance office on 01708 255482 or email [finance@cooperscoborn.co.uk](mailto:finance@cooperscoborn.co.uk) to make alternative arrangements. Completion of the online Google Form is mandatory and students for whom permission has not been given will not be allowed to take part in the trip. Taking no action with regards to consent, will result in us being unable to take your son/daughter off the school site.

You will receive a Parentpay log-on (new parents) in the next 24 hours, if not already and the £40 should be paid using this method.

Your son/daughter will need to wear old sports clothing (clothing could get very dirty, wet and damaged!). They will need a warm waterproof jacket and bring a full packed lunch, as well as plenty of fluids. They also need to bring a spare t-shirt and jogging bottoms etc, in the eventuality of getting

wet. In late September, the weather could be variable and so both waterproofs and sun cream may be advisable!
