Dear Parent(s)/ Carer(s)

As we approach the final 2 months of your son/daughter's career at Coopers' Coborn, I wanted to communicate the arrangements for study leave, prior to the A Level examinations.

A Level examinations begin in earnest during the week of 23rd May, however the vast majority of examinations take place in June, after the May half term holiday.
