It's been another exceptional sporting year – and schools all over the country turned in a series of outstanding performances to reach School Sport Magazine's exclusive top sports schools list.

Our third top 200 chart again celebrates the best of the best with state schools battling it out with their independent rivals on the same list.

And once again the list rates performance above everything else with results compiled from more than 20 different sports and more than 120 different events.

Showcasing the sporting achievements of the hundreds of schools that take competition very seriously, Millfield School retained their top spot for their tenth win in eleven years.

The Somerset school turned in another brilliant all-round performance with national success in sports ranging from rugby union, tennis, athletics and table tennis to swimming, netball, squash and hockey.

Reclaiming their second position was

Guildford High School, whose achievements included success in a range of sports including athletics, swimming, netball, lacrosse and cross country.

Moving up to their best position to date in third was Derbyshire's Repton School, with national victories in cricket and hockey.

Two more girls' schools finished fourth and sixth in a fantastic year for female sport thanks to great performances from Putney HS and Surbiton HS.

Topping the state school performance ratings – and reclaiming their top spot – was Northampton School for Boys, who moved up eleven places to ninth.

Close behind were fellow state schools Coopers Company & Coborn School (14th), South Hunsley School (15th), St Peter's Catholic HS, Wigan (17th) and Great Sankey High School (18th).

It meant that more state schools appeared in the top 20 with five, compared to three last year, and more took their place in the top 200 – 84 compared to 70.
