## 8. Social problems and global issues (Eine wunderbare Welt) (AQA spec 2.2, 2.3)

WHY? Social and global problems are key topics in listening and reading exams. You need to learn ways of strategically revising vocabulary in preparation of your remock and for your final exams.

The topics you learn about include:

- ⇒ using adjectives as nouns
