CCCS Educational Trips and Visits - Menu of Activities Available

As a school we pride ourselves on the breadth, and quality, of our extra-curricular programme. Educational trips and visits are important aspects of this provision, run by departments and school staff throughout the year. These opportunities give students access to multiple enriching experiences, bring the curriculum to life, build 'cultural capital' and help to develop personal, social and critical thinking skills.

Many free day trips, and sporting fixtures, take place across the year and full information on these are communicated through departments and our online extra-curricular management system, SOCS. However, in order to give an overview of the more extensive trips that require more significant costs, the attached 'menu of activities' has been put together. The aim of this is to help parents plan out which trips may be available in upcoming years so that finances can be planned accordingly.
