## Re: Go4Schools for new parents/carers

Dear parent(s) and carer(s)

As a new Year 12 parent/carers to the school, we wanted to introduce you to a critical system which we will use over the course of the next 2 years: Go4Schools.

Go4Schools is an industry leading, internet-based software package which schools primarily use for 3 reasons:

- To register students (attendance)
- To record academic attainment and progress (assessment)
- To report on behaviour (positive and negative)

### Attendance Monitoring:

On Go4Schools, you are able to monitor your son/daughter's attendance each day and their attendance to lessons. You can also view when they are late.

### Academic Attainment:

It is important that students and parents/carers know how students are progressing in subjects. At least once a term some form of formal feedback is given via Go4Schools. However, you are able to view your son/daughter's progress on key assessments as they are marked, in real time.

### Behaviour:

During the course of the academic year, subject staff may wish to praise and reward a student's behaviour (through House Points) or register a formal concern; this is done via the Go4Schools system. Where a teacher feels there is a cause for concern then a student will be informed, the parent and the pastoral team will be notified of the concern via the Go4Schools system behaviour module. You are able to receive a 'weekly summary' of any behavioural logs each week.
