Re: Launch of the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)

Dear parent(s)/carer(s)

This morning we launched the EPQ programme with the Year 12 cohort.

The EPQ is a stand-alone qualification where students complete an extended university-style dissertation and associated project over a period of 12 months, supported by an in-school Project Supervisor. It is a highly independent qualification and is not suitable for all students.

Students will be asked to join a competitive application process for the qualification, but it is hoped that we are able to support as many students as possible.

The deadline for applications is in 10 days' time on **Thursday 28th March at 1pm**; this is deliberate to ensure that student applications are completed before the Easter holiday and therefore do not interfere with the all-important internal examination preparation. The application process was explained in detail to all students this morning. If your son/daughter is interested in pursuing the EPQ then they will have a substantive amount of work to complete over the next 12 months, in addition to A Level study; it is important that we stress this at this point. Similarly, the muse devote time to putting forward a competitive application.

If successful, your son/daughter will be notified after the internal examinations and will start the qualification in late May.
