Reports to	Head of Physical Education and Sport		
Job Purpose	 To provide direction, support and vision to a dynamic rugby programme whilst shaping students core value of "Love as Brethren" in a school that values this, and all sport, as a major part of its ethos. To supervise and support the learning of classes, delivering pre-set work, in cover lessons. 		
Duties	 To implement strategies to improve the standard of the student's skills and knowledge of rugby through training sessions before school, at lunchtimes, after school and weekends. To continue to promote and raise the profile of rugby within school and beyond within local, county, and national fixtures. To establish and maintain a purposeful, positive working atmosphere which supports student progress. 		
	 To communicate and consult with parents of students as necessary, including telephone calls, emails and parental meetings. To engage with all necessary organisations such as Essex RFU, Saracens RFU and England RFU. To oversee the rugby fixture programme, including Saturdays. To arrange and manage any domestic and international rugby tours. To contribute to the day-to day running of the PE department. To act as a cover teacher in PE and non-PE lessons providing professional guidance to classes, setting high expectations of conduct and behaviour and monitoring student progress within the lesson. 		
General	 To comply with individual responsibilities, in accordance with the role, for health & safety in the workplace.
