As we approach the final few weeks of your son/daughter's time at Coopers' Coborn, we wanted to write to communicate to you the arrangements for Year 13's last day at school: Friday 10th May

We recognise that the day is a very special one for all concerned and in order to celebrate this event, we have organised the following programme:

9:30am: Students arrive to 'Farewell Breakfast' in the main school canteen

Teachers and students sign books/shirts and say farewells

10:45am: Leavers' Assembly in the main School Theatre

11:45am: Final Farewells

12:15pm: Students leave the school site

The school will meet the cost of breakfast – there will be no charge to students; there will be a vegetarian option available.

The programme for the day will be explained to students in an assembly on Tuesday 7th May at 8:35am, in the School Theatre. Therefore, it is vital that your son/daughter attends the assembly, at 8.35am, to hear the important information we will be sharing. We will also discuss the A Level examinations and plan for A Level Results' Day in this assembly.

The last day has always run very smoothly and our students are always a credit to themselves and the school; we are convinced that the class of 2024 will be no different. It is important however, that the school's expectations are made clear:

- Students are expected in school on this day in full uniform as on any other day. Any student who is dressed inappropriately will be sent home and will miss out on the activities.
- If students wish to sign shirts then it is important that this is not done in crucial lesson time, prior to the 10th May. If students wish to sign school shirts then a spare shirt should be brought in to sign on 10th May, any student signing the shirt they are wearing will be sent home.
- Finally, should any student partake in any activity considered inappropriate then we will have no hesitation in contacting future employers and universities.

Following the 10th May, students formally commence their study leave and are only required to be in school for their public examinations. If your son/daughter does wish to attend school in order to use the study facilities in the 6th Form, such as the Learning Zone, then it is critical that they:
