Appointment times will be sent via parent mail.

During the meeting students will be introduced to Unifrog <u>www.unifrog.org</u>. This online platform is designed to support careers development and promote independent planning for the future. Parents can also gain access to the resources on Unifrog by login in with this sign up code **CCCSparents.** This code will be valid for the next 90 days.

Following the meeting, a personal action plan will be created for each student with specific targets to support their next steps. Action plans will be shared with students via their Unifrog account. A copy will be sent be sent via parent mail.

In addition to the work I will be undertaking with you son/daughter, I wanted to sign post you to the prospects service which is available for further careers information, advice and guidance.
