The checklist also gives some practical advice of what students should bring with them on the day.

One final reminder – if your son/daughter has had a massive change of heart and wishes to change their university course now, or indeed apply to university for the first time, before the publication of A Level results – then 'Clearing' actually opens in the next week (the first week in July). Whilst this is only likely to affect 1-2 students – I wanted to flag it to all parents/carers; in reality most students use Clearing on Results Day.
