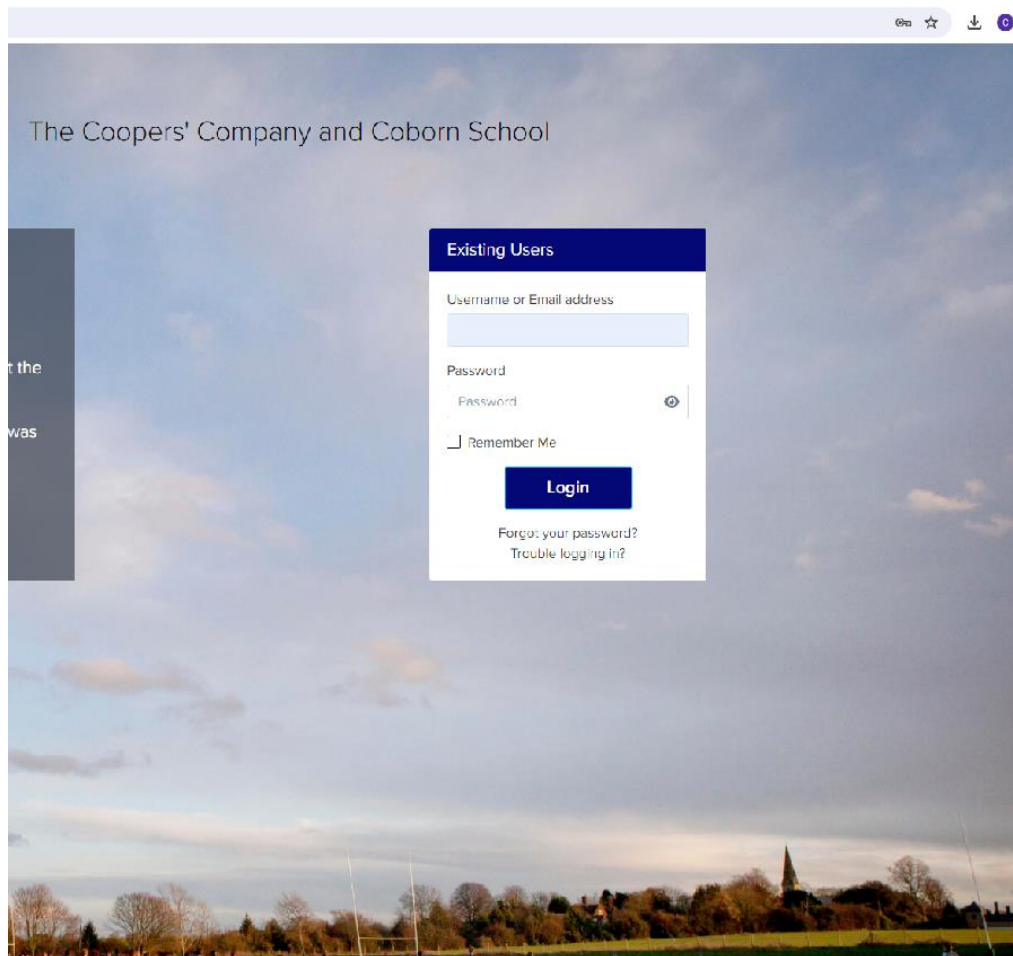
- You MUST get:

- You will need to log-in to your Applica Application (if you no longer have access to the email used for your original application you can create a new log-in).




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# GCSE Results Day Logistics

- GCSE grades need to be uploaded by 12.00 noon on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2025.
- When updating your GCSE results it is **imperative that you upload a copy of your GCSE results along with photographic identification**. Without this information we will not be able to process your application.
- You must also change your predicted grades to **ACHIEVED**:



- They will help prepare you for September



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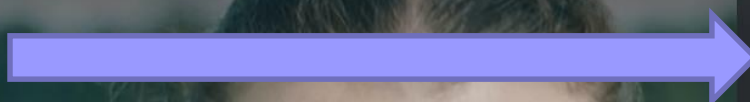
