Following on from Mrs Davies whole-school letter about Sport Day, I wanted to confirm the specific arrangements for Year 12.

The Coopers' Coborn Sports Day is an important event in the school calendar, encapsulating our motto of 'Love as Brethren', in which all members of our school community take part in a range of athletic events. Year 12, like all other year groups in the school are expected to take part fully:

- either as competitors in one of the athletics events
- as organisers/supervisors supporting the PE Department on the day
- or taking on a role encouraging and supporting participating students on the day

All Year 12 students are expected to attend school this day in full school sports uniform i.e. appropriate sports clothing – ideally a polo shirt and tracksuit. Students should not be wearing vests or any clothing deemed inappropriate for an educational setting.

8:35am	Students arrive as usual and register with their Form Tutor
9am – 10am	Period 1 lesson as usual
10am – 11am	Period 2 lesson as usual
11am – 11:30am	Extended break – students can access the 6 th Form Canteen
11:30am – 1pm	All Year 12 students are on the School Field taking part in Sports Day
1pm	Year 12 students dismissed from Sports Day and can travel home. The school day finishes at 1pm for 6 th Form students. No lessons take place Period 5 or Period 6. Please note, Year 12 students who wish to use the study facilities in the Learning Zone can still do so in the afternoon as usual.

The plan for the day is as follows:

It is important that an eye is kept on the weather, so please ensure your son/daughter has waterproof clothing in the likely event of a sudden downpour. Similarly, sun cream and a hat will be equally important if it is hot; there is no shade on the school field and so it is crucial that students have adequate sun protection. Any students who suffer from hay fever, should take associated medication in advance.

This is a unique opportunity in the school calendar for students and staff to come together to celebrate all that is so special about our school community. Due to the event taking place on school site, unfortunately we cannot facilitate parents spectating this year. Despite this, we will endeavour to make the day as special as possible for the students and look forward to supporting them throughout.
